**For other sizes, you can quickly and easily work out the Conversions for yourself, using the following simple formulae;**

To convert <b>Centimetres to Inches</b>	multiply by; <b>0.3937</b>	<b>mm to Inches</b> ; multiply by; <b>0.03937</b>
To convert <b>Metres to Feet</b>	multiply by; <b>3.281</b>	<b>Metres to Inches</b> ; multiply by; <b>39.37</b>
